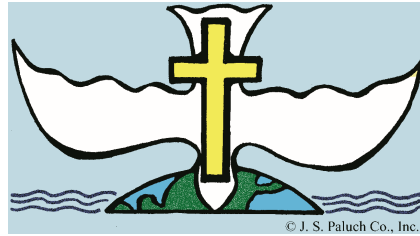

A Message from Fr. Mark:

This.... Even though it is Ordinary Time, you may have noticed that today I was wearing white for Mass. This weekend and next we are celebrating two important Solemnities of Ordinary Time. They are always celebrated on the two Sundays after the Easter season has drawn to a close with Pentecost. I like to view them as our Easter "after parties"! This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, and next weekend the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

This year the great 90 days of Lent and Easter were bookended for us by two tremendously successful parish social events. On Mardi Gras we hosted a thank you reception for all of those who serve as ministers in the parish, and last weekend almost 400 members of the community enjoyed our Pentecost "Family Fun" Picnic. Flocknote enables us to reach you where you are already at, in your email inboxes and via text message. There's nothing for you to download, or pick up after church, and no need for you to 'check-in-on' anything to stay connected with the parish. By organizing the community into different groups and ministries on Flocknote, any member of the staff or head of a ministry can get messages to exactly those who need it, and to no one who doesn't. You can also reply directly to any email or text message we send, vote in polls, RSVP to events and more. The only thing we need you to do is to register with Flocknote so we can communicate more effectively than ever with you.

To register with Flocknote simply go to our parish webpage: www.stcharleslivermore.org. Underneath the picture at the top of our homepage there is a link to register with Flocknote. All you need to provide is your first and last name, email and mobile number. You will then receive a verification text on your phone, and a verification email. When prompted, we invite you to join the "St. Charles Events' group. Simple as that. So far more than 130 parishioners have signed up, and that number is growing daily. Please sign up ASAP so you don't miss out on anything happening in your parish home.
